


RULE NO. 10—VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

Section VI—Offensive Three-Second Rule a. An offensive player shall not remain for more than three seconds in that part of his free throw lane between the endline and extended 4' (imaginary) off the court and the farther edge of the free throw line while the ball is in control of his team. NBA Official Rules 2020-21

Playing basketball is different from knowing the rules.


Following Jesus is different from knowing theology.
