have. But do this with gentleness and respect,

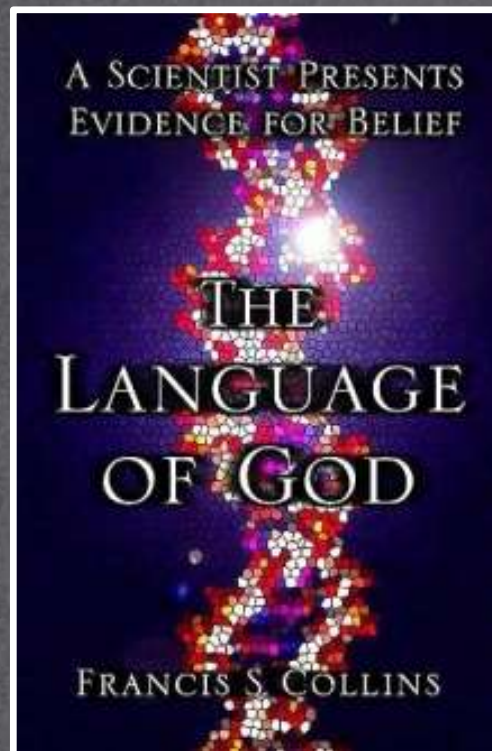

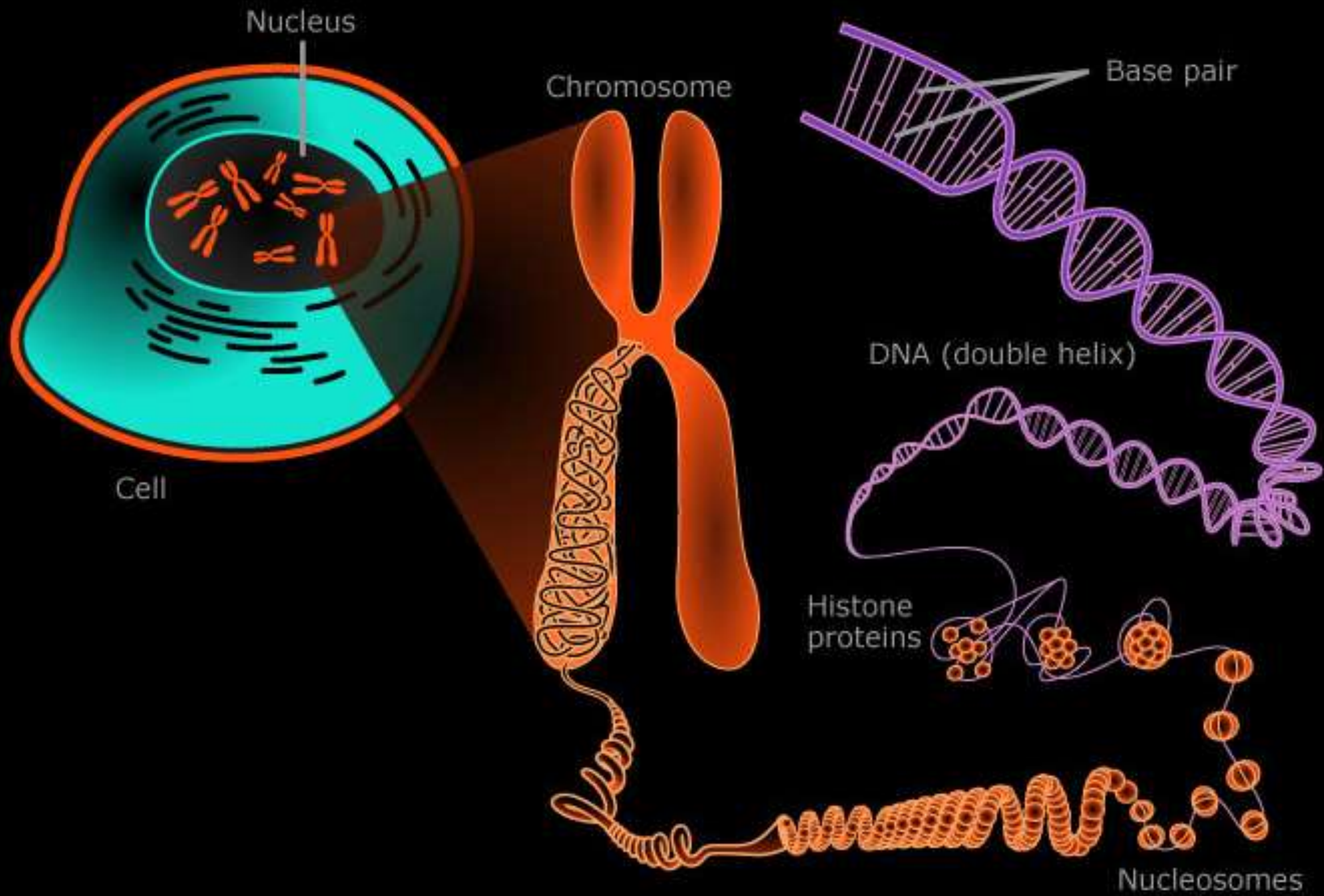
Cosmological Argument

1. Whatever begins to exist has a cause.
2. The universe began to exist.
3. The universe has a cause.

...one can think of DNA as an **instructional script**, a software program, sitting in the nucleus of the cell. Its coding language has only four letters (or two bits, in computer terms) in its alphabet. A particular instruction, known as a gene, is made up of hundreds or thousands of letters of code. All of the elaborate functions of the cell, even in complex an organism as ourselves, have to be directed by the order of letters in this script.

The Design Argument (Teleological)

1. Everything that is designed has a designer.
2. The universe is designed.
3. Therefore, there is a designer.

The Objective Moral Argument

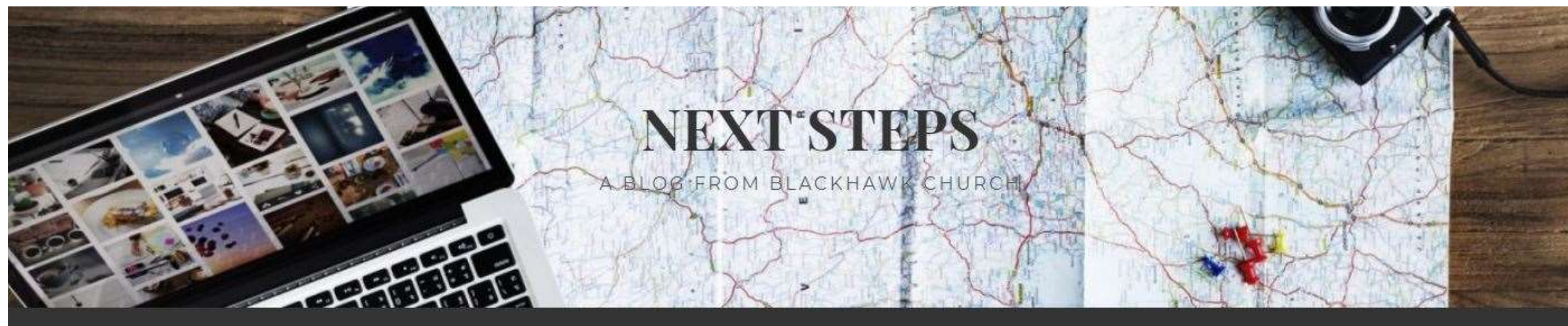
1. If God does not exist, then either objective moral values do not exist or morality exists solely as part of an evolutionary mechanism.
2. Objective moral values do exist.
3. Morality does not exist solely as part of an evolutionary mechanism.
4. Therefore, God exists.

"Morality is a biological adaptation no less than are hands and feet and teeth. ... Considered as a rationally justifiable set of claims about an objective something, ethics is illusory. I appreciate that when somebody says, 'Love thy neighbor as thyself,' they think they are referring above and beyond themselves. ... Nevertheless, ... such reference is truly without foundation. Morality is just an aid to survival and reproduction, ... and any deeper meaning is illusory."
