




16 As it is, you boast in your arrogan[ce]t schemes (άλαζονεία, alazoneia). All such boasting is evil.




Dunning-Kruger Effect Curve




Dunning-Kruger Effect Curve






TRANSFORMATION God cares less about what you do and more about who you become

MISSION God wants you to care about his mission, and he wants you to use your skills for the mission












