



#### The Substitutionary Atonement of Christ

Jesus died so that we won't have to die (i.e. substitution).

<sup>14</sup>... we are convinced that one died for all [substitution], and therefore all died [representation].

Our death isn't a punishment (Christ took that punishment). Our death is so that we can be resurrected to live a new life.




<sup>16</sup> So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer. <sup>17</sup> Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! <sup>18</sup> All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:

#### 2 Corinthians 5:16-18 (NIV)

<sup>19</sup> that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. 


