



eu angelos "good" "message" <sup>1</sup> Paul, a servant of Christ Jesus, called to be an apostle and set apart for the gospel (euangelion) of God— <sup>2</sup> the gospel he promised beforehand through his prophets in the Holy Scriptures

### The Gospel of God in Romans 8

The death of Jesus sets us free from Sin (Rom 8:1-4).

- The Holy Spirit restores us to God's image (Rom 8:5-13).
- We are restored to the status of God's children and given the mission of restoring creation (Rom 8:14-21).

### The Gospel of God in Romans 8

God suffers with us as we work toward the redemption of the world (Rom 8:17-30).
All of this is because God loves us (Rom 8:31-39).






