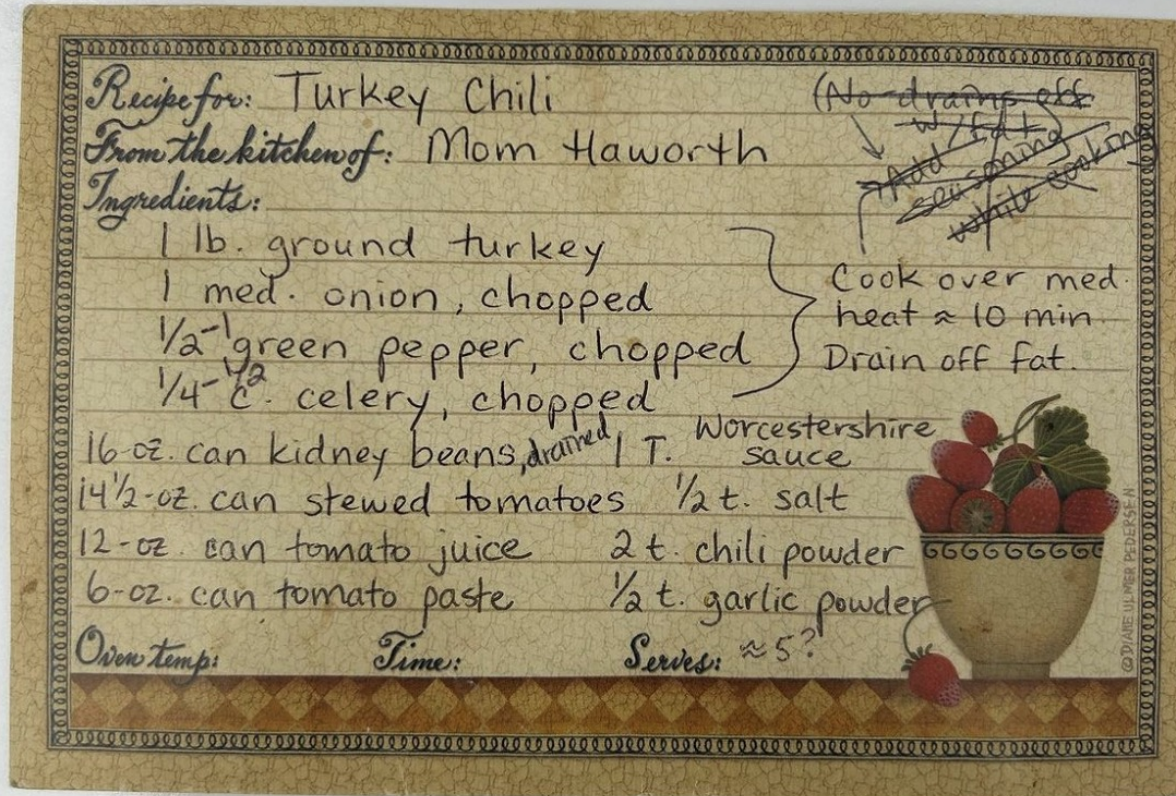




We embrace God's vision of a multicultural kingdom
